This document outlines the expectations that protect the athlete, the family, and eligibility.

Athlete Commitments

- I will represent myself and DSF & YNS with respect (no harassment, bullying, or hate speech).
- I will not post content that is sexual, violent, illegal, or otherwise inappropriate for youth audiences.
- I will not argue online. If I receive negative comments, I will notify my parent/guardian.
- I will not make false claims about products or sponsors.
- I will follow school/team rules about logos, uniforms, facilities, and participation.

Parent/Guardian Commitments

- I will supervise accounts and approve partnerships and paid posts (especially for younger athletes).
- I will ensure the athlete's content is safe, accurate, and compliant.
- I will keep payout and tax-related information under adult control.
- I will contact DSF & YNS support if I'm unsure about a brand deal or post.

Brand & Content Rules (Simple)

- **Always** be honest about what's sponsored (#ad).
- **Never** share addresses, phone numbers, or school schedules.
- **Never** accept offers that feel like recruiting or "pay for performance."
- **Never** use school logos/mascots/uniforms in paid content unless allowed.
- **Always** be grateful: thank supporters, sponsors, coaches, teammates.

By participating in DSF & YNS, the athlete and parent/guardian acknowledge they have read these responsibilities and agree to follow them. DSF & YNS may pause storefront access if safety or eligibility risks arise.
